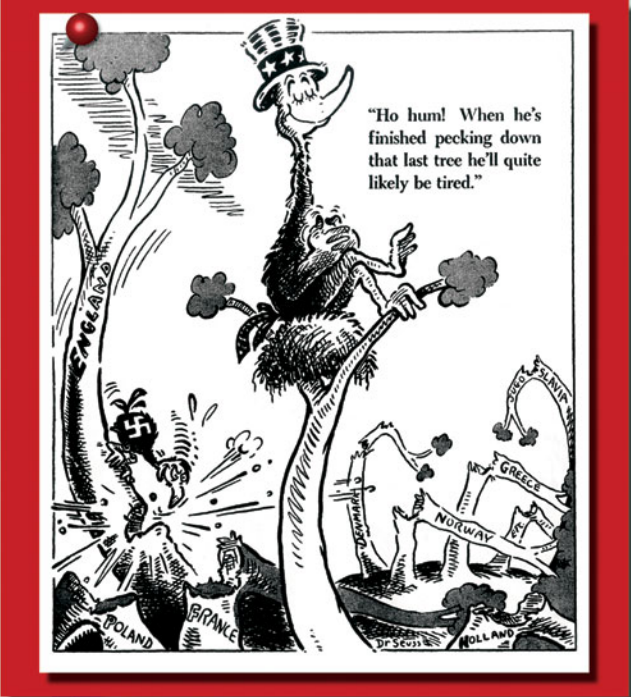




Although the war in Europe is in its second year, 80% of Americans still oppose the idea of U.S. involvement.
