

October 1938: The Service Cross of the German Eagle was presented to Charles Lindbergh by order of the Fuehrer, Adolf Hitler. It was an honor given to foreigners for service to the Third Reich, the title for Nazi Germany. He never gave it back.



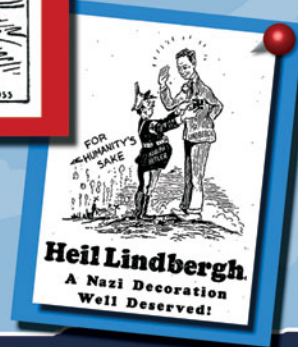
Hey Lindy, don't you know that this jewelry is way out of style?
